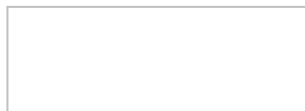
I am writing to provide you an update regarding your status as a graduate student at ASU.

1) Due to you not being in good academic standing in the program in which you are enrolled (Photography), we are rescinding your TAship assignment for Fall term 2016. Photography faculty met July 8 and made this progress report. According to the ASU Graduate College TA/RA handbook "In considering reappointments, the hiring unit or project director must consider the TA's/RA's contribution to the objectives of the unit or project along with the assistant's/associate's academic progress."

2) Due to the recent interim suspension which prohibits you from entering ASU property, in anticipation of incoming student and program needs, we will be carefully moving the contents of your current studio to your new assigned studio space.
